I. The Fourth Vision: The 144,000 and the Lamb (14:1-5)

- 1 Lamb** Had John seen the Lamb before this? 5:6
“Lamb” ... in Revelation = _____ times
standing on Mt. Zion =
144,000 = See 7:4-8
had his name and the Father’s name written on their foreheads John 10:30

- 2 like the roar of rushing waters and a loud peal of thunder**
How was our Savior’s voice described in the opening verses (1:15) of Revelation?
harps ... in Revelation= _____ times
- 3 sang a new song** See 5:9
four living creatures=
elders = ? 24 elders in 4:4=
- 4 not defile themselves with women=**
See 21:2 II Cor. 11:2
they follow the Lamb
were purchased from among men and offered as firstfruits Eph. 5:25-27
- 5 they are blameless**
Why are the elect called blameless? (7:14)
no lie was found in their mouths= ? Jer. 31:34

eternal gospel
flies in mid-air=
every nation, tribe, language, people ... in Revelation= _____ times
fear God = Psalm 130:4
What makes the call to faith in the eternal gospel so urgent?

worship him who made heavens, earth, sea, water

- 8 fallen is Babylon the Great** Isaiah 21:9
What does Babylon the Great symbolize?
What does the angel assure the church by proclaiming the fall of Babylon?
In the OT, what did the fall of Babylon signal for the Jews?
made all the nations drink the maddening wine of her adulteries
How do these verses bring comfort to the faithful?

- 9-10 the beast=**
wine=
full strength
poured into the cup of his wrath=
tormented with burning sulfur
in the presence of the angels and of the Lamb

- 11-12 this calls for patient endurance** See v. 6-7; 8, 9-11
saints who obey God's commandments
