5. Agree or Disagree: The most important thing we can learn from the Bible is that God can help us through every problem we face.

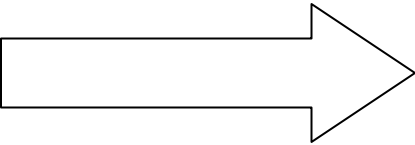
DISTINGUISHING BETWEEN LAW AND GOSPEL

1. Romans 3:20 Through the law we become conscious of sin.
2. John 3:16 For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son.
3. Isaiah 57:21 "There is no peace," says my God, "for the wicked."
4. Ephesians 6:1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.
5. John 1:29 Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!
6. Exodus 20:13 You shall not murder.
7. Galatians 3:26 You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus.
8. Revelation 7:17 And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.
9. Genesis 8:21 Never again will I curse the ground because of man, even though every inclination of his heart is evil from childhood.
10. Psalm 73:24 You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will take me into glory.
11. Hebrews 4:9 There remains, then, a Sabbath-rest for the people of God.
12. John 3:14 Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up.
13. Matthew 7:15 Watch out for false prophets.
14. Ephesians 1:7 In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins.
15. Romans 5:20 Where sin increased, grace increased all the more.
16. 2 Corinthians 5:19 God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting men's sins against them.
17. Romans 4:8 Blessed is the man whose sin the Lord will never count against him.
18. Proverbs 13:13 He who scorns instruction will pay for it, but he who respects a command is rewarded.
19. James 2:10 Whoever keeps the whole law and yet stumbles at just one point is guilty of breaking all of it.
20. Psalm 16:11 You have made known to me the path of life; you will fill me with joy in your presence, with eternal pleasures at your right hand.
