### Class discussion:

1. Evaluate: John says, "It sure is a drag being a Christian. Look at all of the fun I miss out on because of the laws God wants me to follow."
2. Agree or disagree: Most of the time I obey God's law out of love for Jesus, but sometimes I obey it only because I fear punishment.
3. Evaluate: Judy says, "I know that as long as I obey God's law, I will never have any hardship or trouble in my life."
4. Evaluate: Now that I'm a Christian I no longer need God's law to serve as a curb or mirror.
5. Agree or disagree: When a person becomes a Christian, he or she can use the law as a guide to live in a way that pleases God and makes him or her fit for heaven.
