#### **Class discussion:**

- **1.** An unbelieving husband forbids his Christian wife to go to church. What would you do if you were that woman?
- **2.** Evaluate: It's wrong for me to want to make as much money as I can.
- **3.** Show in each example how the 1<sup>st</sup> Commandment serves as both a mirror (to show our sins) and as a guide (to show us how to thank Jesus for taking all our sins away):
  - a. My boss at work tells me to do something dishonest, for example, to lie about a problem with a product the company sells.
  - b. I'm facing a very difficult test at school, and my friend tells me, "You're smart enough to pass that test on your own without any trouble."
- **4.** Evaluate: the Egyptians believe in Ra, you believe in Jesus, and others believe in Allah. It doesn't make any difference what you call him, God is still God.
- **5.** Evaluate: What do you mean, "Why do I wear this cross?" Don't you know that wearing a cross around your neck keeps you safe from accidents?
- **6.** Agree or disagree: Worrying is a sin against the 1<sup>st</sup> Commandment.
- **7.** Agree or disagree: If we could see into people's hearts, we would see that all people have idols that they worship.
- **8.** True or False: It doesn't really matter which religion you belong to, Buddhism, Islam, or Christian or whatever. We all worship the same God.
- **9.** True or False: It's wrong to have insurance or a savings account or investing in retirement funds, because that's not trusting God to take care of you.
