Matthew 28:19-20 Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you.

John 8:31b ...Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples."

Ephesians 4:3 Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

(Colossians 3:16; 1Corinthians 10:16,17; Acts 15:1-32; Galatians 2:1-10)

Hebrews 10:23-25 Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another--and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

# 4. What should we do when we find that a church teaches something other than God's Word? (By *adding* to it, *taking away* from it or *changing* it.) (Ephesians 4:15, 1Timothy 1:18-20)

#### Persistent errorist vs. weakness in faith/questions

2 Timothy 4:3-4 For the time will come when men will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear. They will turn their ears away from the truth & turn aside to myths.

Titus 3:10 But avoid foolish controversies and genealogies and arguments and quarrels about the law, because these are unprofitable and useless. 10 Warn a divisive person once, and then warn him a second time. After that, have nothing to do with him. 11 You may be sure that such a man is warped and sinful; he is self-condemned.

Romans 16:16-18 Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the churches of Christ send greetings. I urge you, brothers, to watch out for those who cause divisions and put obstacles in your way that are contrary to the teaching you have learned. Keep away from them. 18 For such people are not serving our Lord Christ, but their own appetites. By smooth talk and flattery they deceive the minds of naive people.
