Genesis 32

Background/Context

- > Jacob has 12 children while staying with his Uncle Laban
 - 6 sons and 1 daughter through Leah Reuben, Simeon, Levi, Judah, Issachar, Zebulun, Dinah
 - o 2 sons through Rachel's maidservant, Bilhah Dan, Naphtali
 - 2 sons through Leah's maidservant, Zilpah Gad, Asher
 - o 1 son through Rachel Joseph
- > Jacob realizes Laban is taking advantage of him, and decides to hit the road
 - With God's support Genesis 31:13 "I am the God of Bethel, where you anointed a pillar and where you made a vow to me. Now leave this land at once and go back to your native land."
- However, he doesn't notify Laban who tracks him with intent to bring harm to Jacob, but God intervenes. The two make a pact and draw a boundary which neither will cross.
- > Jacob continues on his journey home.

<u>Read 32:1&2</u>

1) On the road home, what spectacular thing happened?

2) Take a minute to read the following passages about the presence and purpose of angels on earth:

- Psalm 34:7 The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them.
- Psalm 91:9 If you make the Most High your dwelling—even the LORD, who is my refuge—10 then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent. 11 For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; 12 they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone.
- Hebrews 1:14 Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation? 13:2 Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it.
- Matthew 18:10 See that do not look down on one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven.

With the people around you, answer the following questions:

- > T/F God sends his angels to protect all people on earth.
- ➤ T/F Angels are invisible.

Read Verses 9-12

1) What was Jacob thankful for?

2) What was Jacob fearful of more than anything?
