Isaiah 9:6

A NOTE FROM THE TREASURER

A change in record keeping for Faith Ev. Lutheran Church. In order to record a Gift-In-Kind donation into the church records a proof of purchase is required. Unless it is and older donated item then proof of value is needed. If anyone wishes to give a Gift-In-Kind donations without proof-of-purchase or value these will not be recorded in the end of year statements for benefit on a member taxes.

FUNDRAISING: The Council would like to remind everyone not to bring fundraisers to church for solicitation. Its not that we don't want to support our youth, its just not the message that we want to send to visitors and guests.

Reimbursement Form: Can be found in the track rack in the hallway. Approval to expend money that is to be reimbursed to the purchaser, must be authorized in advance from the respective council member. When you have approval and expended funds for a group or project, you must fill out the reimbursement form, attach receipts and get the signature of the Church Council member who is responsible for the budget in his area. (He must keep track of how your money is spent and if any money is available). Ask any council member if you have questions.
