

Jesus is...Son of God and Son of Man

Luke 1:35
"The holy one to be born will be called the Son of God."

Matthew 20:28
"The Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

People spend a lot of time, money and effort to get a title after their name. Masters, doctorates and other post-graduate programs are in high demand. The appeal is understandable. Titles such as Doctor, Professor and a host of others provide opportunities to better ourselves and our circumstances.

There was one who had the highest of all titles already at his birth. The Bible describes it this way: "The holy one to be born will be called the Son of God" (Luke 1:35). Jesus is holy. He is the true Son of God. The titles "Holy One" and "Son of God" indicate that all power, wisdom and authority belonged to Jesus at birth because as true God he possessed them from eternity. His name is above every name and over every title and authority that can be given.

But that did not stop Jesus from seeking another title. This one was decidedly a step down. It did not require a four-year graduate program or many evening classes. Rather, it required humble service. The Bible teaches, "The Son of Man did

not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many" (Matthew 20:28). Jesus, who took the title *Son of Man*, did not come from heaven to earth to be waited on hand and foot. Rather, he came to take up our cause and to die a humble death on the cross—a death that should have been ours.

Give thanks that out of love for us, the one with the title *Son of God* was also willing to take the title *Son of Man*, in order to die for us on the cross. Our Savior Jesus is both true God and true Man. He is the perfect Savior we desperately needed—one who is holy and lived in our place and one whose innocent death counted for the whole world. Because Jesus loved us enough to do that for us, now through faith in him we have been given a new title as well: *Child of God!* Bear that title proudly and live your life for the One who gave it to you.

Call Update



The yard sale is set for June 7th from 8am -2pm


Please set your items aside to donate for the sale. There will be drop off times the week before, so watch the newsletters and bulletins for times.

Youth Group

On June 7th, the youth group will be taking their annual trip to Holiday World. We ask all people going to be at the church by 8:30AM. We'll hit the road right on 9:00. We should get there around 10:30 our time (9:30 their time), which is about half an hour after they open. We'll spend the day there and leave around 7:30PM or 8:00 THEIR time. We should get back around 10:00 or 10:30 OUR time. For any non youth group members and non youth group member invites and/or family, the cost is \$30.95 IF we have enough people to come for the group discount. Congregation members will get that group discount, however, they won't get the youth group discount. Youth group members and youth group member invites and/or family will only have to pay \$20.95 and the last ten dollars will come from the money we earned specifically for this trip. I recommend about thirty dollars spending money. That should cover lockers (which we share and split the price), food, and souvenirs.

June 7th is not that far away. Money should be in by the Sunday after next, June 1st. We'll divvy up the tickets to the drivers before we leave the church that morning. Each driver will have the tickets of the kids they are driving. That's another thing!
