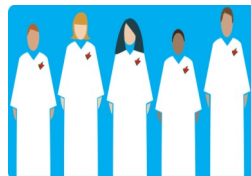
### Youth Group Road Trip to Holiday World

## Vicar in Mission Setting Approved !

WELS Board for Home Missions approved Faith Lutheran to have a vicar in Mission Setting. A vicar is a student at Wisconsin Lutheran Seminary who has completed two years of seminary training. The vicar year is a hands-on ministry training year, similar to an internship. The Conference of Presidents will assign the vicars on May 21st. The vicar will move to Kentucky in August and spend a year with us.

The cost to have a vicar is subsidized because of our mission status and the majority of the cost is covered by a grant. Our congregation's financial responsibility will be \$12,000 to support the vicar program.

Let us thank God for the opportunity to participate in the training of our future pastors!
